1. **PURPOSE.** This directive establishes policies, procedures and responsibilities for conducting oversight of State regulatory programs and State and Tribal abandoned mine reclamation (AMLR) programs. This directive applies to all Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSM) organizational units and personnel involved in oversight of State regulatory programs and State and Tribal AMLR programs during Evaluation Year (EY) 1994 (July 1, 1993-June 30, 1994). It does not affect oversight workplans prepared for EY 1994, but it shall be used when preparing workplans for EY 1995.

2. **SUMMARY OF CHANGES.** Since this directive was last revised on July 8, 1992, the following changes have been made:

a. Dates have been modified throughout the directive and appendix as necessary to reflect the extension of this guidance through the 1994 evaluation year.

b. Part 4.a. of the directive has been revised to clarify that the Director or his/her designee can establish national priority review topics and standardized nationwide element- or subelement-specific evaluation methodologies when desired; they need not be set forth through the directive process.

c. Parts 4.a.(2)(f) and 5.b. of the directive and Part II of the appendix have been revised to delete the requirement for quarterly workplan progress reports since this information is already included in the monthly reports prepared by the Field Office Director for the Assistant Director, Field Operations.

d. Part 5.c. of the directive has been removed, deleting the requirement that copies of Tables 2 and 6-10 be submitted to the Assistant Director, Reclamation and Regulatory Policy.

e. Part 5.d. (now 5.b.) of the directive has been revised to extend the time allotted to the Field Office Director for preparation of the annual report from 30 days to 45 days after the close of the evaluation year.

f. Part 6 of the directive has been revised to reflect prior changes to Directives INE-29 and REG-8.
